This is how the program works. Companies in town would pay an Adopt volunteer to clean up areas near the highways in Tiverton (entrance, exit ramps) and, as a result, companies would leave a sign there stating they have adopted that area—giving them free advertising.

OTHER BUSINESS:

- 1. Adopt-An-Area bag inventory/list of volunteers at library (Vicki)
 The inventory of bags at the library are currently stocked.
 Those in the community picking up bags must be informed that once the bags are full they must be dropped off at DPW or if they are too heavy, the volunteer must call DPW and ask for them to be picked up. (Since the bags are donated by the DPW are a different color. Neighbors get upset when they see a different colored bag on the curb on a trash pick-up day.) The library staff volunteers will inform those that pick up bags about the process of properly disposing full bags of trash.
